**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH, NORTH CAROLINA, AMENDING
CHAPTER 73: TRAFFIC SCHEDULES, SCHEDULE II: STOP SIGNS, TO ADD STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF
EAST FOURTH STREET AND MADISON STREET TO MAKE THE INTERSECTION A FOUR-WAY STOP**

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-07

WHEREAS, the Town of Plymouth is granted broad police power authority to enact, regulate and enforce ordinances by authority of N.C.G.S. 160A-174 and also has the authority to regulate vehicle and traffic control, and specifically stop signs at intersections, within its jurisdiction pursuant to NCGS 20-158, 160A-296(a)(5) and 160A-300 and pursuant to the Town of Plymouth Code of Ordinances in Title VII: Traffic Code, Section 70.31 et seq.; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Plymouth has determined that the current Ordinances of the Town along with reference to Chapter 73: Traffic Schedule II should be amended to authorize installation of additional stop signs at the intersection of East Fourth Street and Madison Street to make the intersection a four-way stop; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council has deemed that such action is in the best interest and safety of the citizens of the Town of Plymouth and the general public.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Plymouth Town Council that:

Chapter 73, Schedule II: Stop Signs and any previous Ordinance regarding stop signs at the intersection of East Fourth and Madison Streets in Plymouth, North Carolina, are hereby amended to add stop signs at the intersection of East Fourth Street and Madison Street to make the intersection a four-way stop.

This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

Adopted this the 11th day of October, 2021 – motion made by Councilwoman Teel and seconded by Councilman Wobbleton with a vote of 6-0.
